There was a case, “The Bhopal disaster or Bhopal gas tragedy was a chemical accident on the night of 2–3 December 1984 at the Union Carbide India Limited (UCIL) pesticide plant in Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh, India. In what is considered the world's worst industrial disaster,^[3] over 500,000 people in the small towns around the plant were exposed to the highly toxic gas methyl isocyanate(MIC).^[4] Estimates vary on the death toll, with the official number of immediate deaths being 2,259. In 2008, the Government of Madhya Pradesh paid compensation to the family members of 3,787 victims killed in the gas release, and to 574,366 injured victims.^[1] A government affidavit in 2006 stated that the leak caused 558,125 injuries, including 38,478 temporary partial injuries and approximately 3,900 severely and permanently disabling injuries.^[5] Others estimate that 8,000 died within two weeks, and another 8,000 or more have since died from gas-related diseases.”² After this case, more focus was brought to environment laws and more laws related to this was passed to protect the environment. But in present time, there is need for more stringent laws that people should follow. There should be focus on improving the waste rather than reducing the waste because people will do what they want to, we cannot do something to reduce it majorly but what we can do is how to improve it. For ex: Instead of focusing on how to control the use of plastic, there should be focus on how to reuse the used plastic. Protecting the nature should be the almost priority like other important things. So by concluding, i think that it is necessary to make some stringent laws regarding this , because if we see the bigger picture, we are ruining the environment and it will be loss to us and our coming generations.
